

VEGAS ARTISTS GUILD
Policies for Guild-sponsored Art Exhibits

The requirements that apply to all Guild Art Exhibits are listed in these policies. Each art exhibit will have specific requirements that adhere to these general policies. The Board can change or modify these policies as deemed necessary.

1. Eligibility. The instructions for each show will specify those who are eligible to submit entries. Basically, the shows will be open to all artists or to Guild members only and may be juried or not. The number of pieces per artist and any required fees will be specified for each show.
2. Originality. The artwork submitted to Guild art shows must be original, unsupervised artwork and without the use of photographs taken by anyone other than the artist. The artwork must not have been exhibited in previous Vegas Artists Guild shows.
3. Specifications. Any limitations on size will be based on the available space in the exhibit hall and will be specified for each show. Three-dimensional artwork will be accepted if display space can be arranged and will be specified for each show.
4. Framing. All artwork must be adequately framed. If artwork needs glass or plexiglass as part of the framing, paintings larger than 16 by 20 inches must use plexiglass. Colored mats and/or liners will be acceptable. All paintings must have a backing board and must be ready to hang. The wire must be able to support the weight of the painting and be attached with screws or screw eyes. No clips or claw hangers will be accepted.
